MOSH / MOAH Mineral Oil Statement

On February 10th, 2020, the French government promulgated the Law 2020-105 banning mineral oil inks on packaging for the purpose of waste management and circular economy, and a new Arrête ministerial ordinance was promulgated on May 3rd, 2022, defining the definition and limits of mineral oil. Operational FAQs have also been posted on October 12th, 2022, for the first time. The detail is as follows.

Prohibition of the use of mineral oil ink for the following:

- Packaging (after January 1st, 2023) Regulation is in effect
- Advertising / Pamphlet (after January 1st, 2023) *Regulations are in effect
- General Print (January 1st 2025 and later)

The use of mineral oil inks in the following concentrations is prohibited on the applicable items.

Component	Concentration (Regulation Effective Date)
① MOAH Mineral oil aromatic hydrocarbons consisting of 1-2 aromatic rings	1% or less (Regulations in effect on Jan 1 st , 2023)
	0.1% or less (Regulation in effect on Jan 1 st , 2025)
② MOAH Mineral oil aromatic hydrocarbons consisting of 3-7 aromatic rings	0.0001% or less (Regulations in effect on Jan 1 st , 2025)
③ MOSH Mineral oil saturated hydrocarbons with a carbon number of 16 to 35	0.1% or less (Regulation in effect on Jan 1 st , 2025)
